**DUE TO UBER/LYFT'S
MISSCLASSIFICATION OF THEIR DRIVERS
AS "INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS"
DRIVERS ARE SUBJECTED TO:**

LOWER WAGES

Drivers are deprived of obtaining a minimum wage, overtime compensation, paid leave, disability leave, and other benefits.

LIMITED PROTECTIONS AGAINST HARASSMENT AND ASSAULT

Both companies disclaim responsibility for their drivers' safety and fail to implement protective measures.

FEWER PROTECTIONS FOR DRIVERS' HEALTH

Uber's and Lyft's vehicle insurance provides insufficient coverage causing drivers to absorb substantial costs. Workers who get injured or become ill will not be able to access compensation.

DISPROPORTIONATE HARM AGAINST WORKERS OF COLOR

Prop 22 further contributes to racial disparities by excluding folks of color from labor protections.
